PARENT-TEACHER MEETING

Parent teacher meeting is a prominent and notable feature of the school curriculum. The motive is to have close interaction of parents with teachers related to the progress shown by their wards and finding workable solutions to the problems coming in the way of development of their ward. It is mandatory for all parents to attend the Parent Teacher Meet. In case of an extreme situation where the parent cannot attend, written intimation should be provided. If the child is not making the desired progress, parents are welcome to contact the Principal, Vice Principal, Headmistress, Class Teacher or the concerned Subject Teacher to discuss remedial measures that can be taken. Such meetings, however, can be arranged on appointment made through the office of the Principal and on no account should parents contact the teachers in the classrooms directly.





SICK BAY

Under close guidance and supervision of our Chairman Dr. Piyush Sunda who himself is a pediatrician, we provide medical support to the students. A well stocked sick bay has been created within the campus. First aid kit is placed in all hostels. Students who need specialised medical treatment are provided transport and escort to the medical facilities in the city. Parents are kept informed about the treatment and follow-up action taken.



CAFETERIA

The school has a spacious spick-and-span cafeteria to provide refreshment to the students and staff. The standard of food in quality and quantity is absolutely hygienic. Less oily, nutritious eatables are provided and the quality of the food items served at the cafeteria and its neatness is constantly monitored by a team of teachers.



HOSTEL FACILITY

Built in a peaceful pastoral setting within the school campus, yet only a stone's throw from the school's central building, the self-contained, purposefully-built residence halls provide a wonderful opportunity for students to experience a greater degree of independence and privacy.

Hostel facility is available to the students who are unable to commute from distant areas.

Our hostels have double, triple and quadruple bed rooms. Attached washroom facility is also available in many hostels. All the hostels are centrally air-cooled. Boys and girls are housed in separate buildings.

The rooms of the hostel are modern, comfortable places for students to study, socialise and relax. As adult mentors, the residence hall staff provide the daily support needed to meet academic, emotional and social needs of the students.







LIFE IN RESIDENCE HALLS

The students of residence hall follow a fixed schedule during weekdays. The day starts with an early morning workout that may involve jogging, walking, aerobics, stretching and yoga, followed by breakfast. After school hours, the students take part in outdoor games activity followed by tutoring session and study time. Play time and outdoor games include lawn and table tennis, carom, basketball, cricket, baseball, volleyball and soccer. Students also get some leisure time daily to watch news, read books or attend other personal chores. During weekends, in addition to the regular study hours, students spend time on entertainment, swimming, and developing hobbies. The duration of entertainment, outdoor sports and indoor activities depends on the students' mood and weather condition. Once a month, students are taken out of the campus for shopping and entertainment. On a long weekend, students go for a full day outing/picnic. Participation in these activities are optional. Students also celebrate various festivals of the country.







DINING HALL

We have three spacious dining halls which can accommodate 500 students at a time. Each has enough airy space with the service areas in one side with three wings. This allows us to divide students classwise.

At breakfast and lunch time the staff sit at the students' tables to provide both supervision, create a family atmosphere and share meals together. These are the moments when students happily raise concerns with staff in an entirely non-judgmental manner. In the evening, dinner is a more relaxed affair with students sitting with their friends and staff providing a watchful eye on their behaviour dispassionately.


A first rate professional catering service is rendered by external contractors. To provide variety, they collect various recipes from all over India including regional specialities.

Hygiene and quality are rigorously enforced to ensure that students receive the enriched nourishment and teachers carefully (but quietly) monitor students to check that they have dinning etiquettes.









LIBRARY

The school has a fully equipped library with a vast collection of books and educational periodicals. The library is thoroughly automated and circulation of books is done through a proper system. Teachers and students utilise the library for reference connected with their projects as well as for leisure reading. Separate enclosures for self-study is made available for senior students.

The library is open from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. on all working days. Students can get books issued during school hours.

Students are expected to follow the library rules and to maintain the decorum while making the best use of the library facilities. In the junior section, the library period is taken in class. The students may, in addition, can exchange books during the break.

Quiet place for work and study:

The library is meant to be a quiet place for study and reading. 'One should keep his/her voices low'. 'Please keep your voices low'. 'Treat everyone respectfully'. 'Do not disturb others'. 'Use appropriate voice and behaviour'. 'Learn to lower your voice before entering the library' are being conscientiously followed by students in the library. In common silence is maintained in the library.

TRANSPORT

School bus facility is available to Day Scholars. The buses are modern, state of art. The drivers and conductors are selected after due diligence. Bus fee is at reasonable level. Stops are specified. Students are picked and dropped at designated points only.

BUS RULES

Do's

- Do reach the bus stop at least few minutes before the scheduled time of arrival of the school bus.
- Do stay away from the main road while waiting for the school bus.
- Always use zebra crossings while crossing roads.
- Do board the bus in proper queue.
- Do remain seated when the bus is moving.
- Do enter the bus through front door only.
- Do wait for the bus to stop completely before getting down.
- Do allow the bus to move off before crossing the road.



Don'ts

- Do not board or alight from the bus until the bus has come to a complete halt.
- Do not lean out or stick heads or limbs out of the window.
- Do not put your head or hand out of the window.
- Do not speak to the driver while he is driving.
- Do not push or rush to the door to board/to get down the bus.
- Do not fight in the moving bus.
- Do not put your bags on the bus seats.
