Sir/Madam,

With reference to your application dated 16/06/2011, and subsequent inspection of the school, I am directed to convey sanction for provisional affiliation to the above said school for **Senior School Certificate Examination** for a period of **three years w.e.f. 1.4.2012 to 31.3.2015** in the following subjects:-

- (a) Languages:- English Core, Hindi Elective,
(b) Elective Subjects: History, Political Science, Geography, Economics, Mathematic, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Physical Education, Business Studies, Accountancy, Informatics Practice, Entrepreneurship, and Computer Science.

The sanction is subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions in addition to the general conditions intimated at the time of grant of provisional affiliation for secondary classes:

1. "The school will follow syllabi and courses as per scheme of studies prescribed by the Board for Senior School Certificate Examination and changes made therein from time to time."
2. The school will implement Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE) as per the schemes of the Board upto Classes X.
3. As per the newly implemented CCE scheme vide **Circular No. 39/20-09-2009 dated 20.09.2009**, the students of class X will appear in the Summative Assessment-II (SA-II) conducted at the school level only. However, those students of class X, who opt to move out of CBSE system in Class XI to any other Board, will exercise the option to appear in the SA-II conducted at the Board level. Both the students will get the same certificate issued by the Board at the end of class X.
4. The school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued. The school will provide additional suitable facilities for classes XI and XII, as per requirements laid down in the rules.
5. It will increase the number of books in the Library and equipments in the Laboratories/Workshops with adequate games facilities etc. in consonance with the requirements of the Board for Classes XI & XII.
6. It will appoint only qualified staff to teach Classes XI & XII as per requirements laid down by the Board.
7. It will provide facilities for adequate co-curricular and extra-curricular activities for the wholesome development of the students.
8. It will abide itself by the Affiliation Bye Laws of the Board and other rules and regulations prescribed by the Board from time to time.
9. The school will enroll students proportionate to the facilities available in the school as prescribed in the Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board which shall not in general exceed the optimum number as under from Pre-Primary to Class XII :-

(e) Schools running on less than 01 acre campus shall restrict number of students as follows:-

10. School will provide physical facilities as per norms of the Board. The facilities reported at the time of last inspection are as given under:-

11. The school will strictly adhere with all rules regarding safety of students including Fire fighting, Drinking water, Sanitation, Transportation, etc.

12. **Annual fee of Rs. 4500/- @ Rs.1500/- per annum** for three years (01.04.2012 to 31.03.2015) be also remitted at an early date. (In case of overseas Independent school @ Rs. 5000/- p.a. and overseas Kendriya Vidyalayas @ Rs. 3500/- p.a.).

13. The school will apply for further Extension of Provisional Affiliation on the prescribed form together with the prescribed fee of **Rs. 25,000/-** and other essential documents in the preceding year before the expiry of the date.

14. The school will open CBSE pattern classes XI w.e.f. 1.4.2012. Accordingly, 1st Batch of class XII of the school will be appearing at the CBSE Examination to be held in 2014.

15. Other conditions are as per Annexure 'A' enclosed.

16. Special conditions to be complied within three months:-

1. The school is required to re-constitute the SMC as per the provisions of Affiliation Bye-laws of the Board.
2. The school is required to submit Class wise/Section-wise enrollment of students restrict with optimum number of 40 students per section.
3. The school is required to create the Reserve fund as per norms.
4. The school is required to appoint trained/qualified Librarian in (prescribed grade) as per CBSE norms
5. The school is required to furnish a copy of fire safety certificate as per CBSE norms.
6. The school is required to appoint more trained and qualified teachers in order to maintain section teacher ratio of 1:1.5.
7. The school is required to equip Science and Maths labs with adequate apparatus/equipments upto the level of Secondary stage.
8. The school is required to inform the size of the playground.
9. The teachers be sent in-service training programme..
